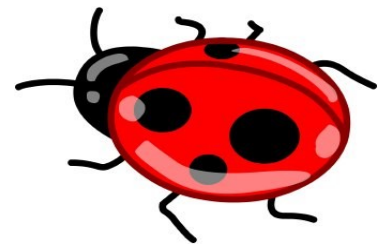


EYFS
