



# Responsible Internet Use.

**I will use the school computers and internet connection for learning. These rules will help me to be fair to others and keep everyone safe.**

I will ask permission before entering web sites, unless my teacher has previously approved that site.

On a network, I will use my classes' own login and password.

I will not look at or delete other people's files.

I will not bring computer software into school without my teacher's permission.

I will only e-mail people I know, or my teacher has approved.

When blogging I will only use my classes' login to write appropriate comments or replies about school related tasks.

The messages I send via email or blog will be polite and sensible and I will consider the feelings of other children and adults.

When sending e-mail, I will not give my home address or phone number, or arrange to meet someone.

I will ask adult permission before opening an e-mail or an e-mail attachment sent by someone I do not know.

I will not use internet chat rooms.

If I see anything I am unhappy or uncomfortable with, or if I receive any messages I do not like, I will tell a teacher immediately.

I know that the school may check my computer files and may monitor the internet sites I visit. I know that they can check messages I send via blog.

**I understand that if I deliberately break these rules, I could be stopped from using the internet or computers.**

The school may exercise its right by electronic means to monitor the use of the school's computer systems, including the monitoring of web sites, the interception of email and the deletion of inappropriate materials in circumstances where it believes inappropriate messages are being sent, unauthorised use of the school's computer system is or may be taking place, or it is being used for criminal purposes or for storing text or imagery which is unauthorised or unlawful.
